1. NAME OF THE TRUST:-

The TRUST is hereby constituted as an irrevocable TRUST and it shall be more particularly known as "Shanti Raj Educational Trust".

The TRUSTEES may change the name of the Trust if they mutually so decide in future.

2. REGISTERED OFFICE:-

The Registered Office of the Trust shall be situated at 34, First Floor, Kavi Raman Path, Near 'Gold Gym', Nageshwar Colony, Boring Road, Patna - 800001.

3. DECLARATION OF THE TRUST AND ITS OBJECTS:-

The TRUSTEES hereby declare that they and the Survivor or survivors of them or other Trustee or Trustees there for the time being hold the said sum of Rs. 1,05,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Five Thousand) only made over by the settler to the Trustees as aforesaid and all Gifts, contributions, subscriptions, donations, bequests and other money or properties as and when the same shall be paid to or invested in them and the moneys, investments and properties as from time to time representing the same upon Trust to apply the same for the benefit of poor and weaker sections for improvement in their social, economic, cultural and environmental condition and their linguistic, religions and educational development and also for the advancement of any other object of their general utility within the State of Bihar (not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit within the territory of India or for charitable purpose which tends development of Theosophy observing the secular character of the nation and for such purpose (without restricting the generality of the foregoing objects) to within the State of Bihar do all or any of the following:-

- (i) To undertake projects, programmes, Schemes, relating to Technical, education such as Hospitals, Charitable Dispensaries, Medical Aid Centers, any other Children, maternity Homes, Nursing Homes, Child Welfare Centers, Sanitarium and other

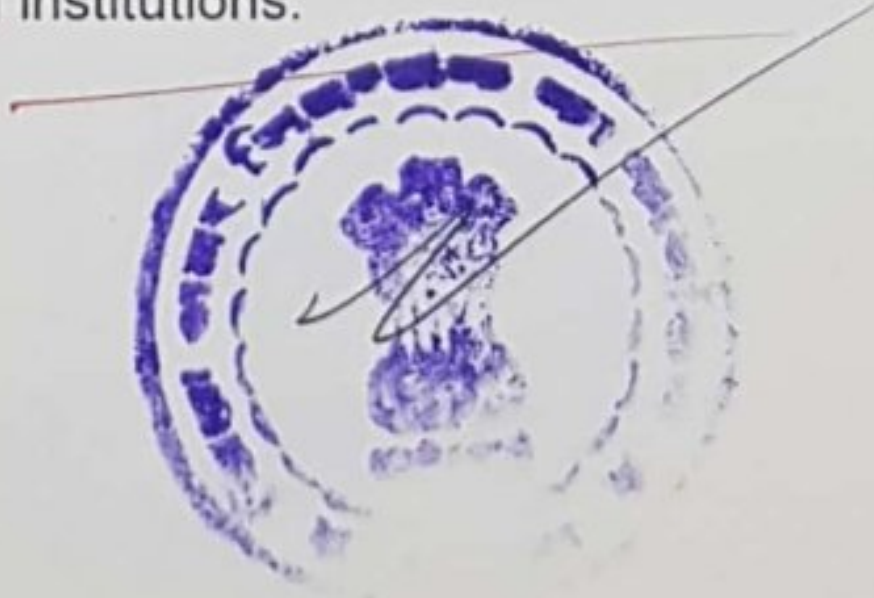
- (ii) To undertake projects, programmes and Schemes, relating to technical and professional education, scientific enquiry, and research and to establish maintain and administer academic institutions under Article 30(i) of the Constitutions of India for imparting Modern Technical and Professional Education to the deserving youths in the Field of Management, Education, Science and Technology Polytechnic, Information Technology, Computer Training Center, Medical College and Hospital, Dental College and Hospital Research Centers, Training Institute, Institute of Business Management, Teachers Training College, Law Institutes and other Institutions of similar nature. So that the deserving young after being trained at these institutions may get employment in their respective fields and thereafter they may substantially contribute to the development of the nation as worthy sons and daughters of India.
- (iii) To help, aid, assist, undertake, establish and maintain and administer under Article 30(i) of the constitution Schools including public schools, Colleges for imparting modern general, vocational, Industrial, Technical Physical, mental moral, Education to the needy and deserving youth for the members of Education, to the needy and deserving youth for the members of Education, Culture, Language, Art, Science, Health and to assist and provide financial assistance to the poor and other people for in other causes of their general utility.
- (iv) To aid, assist and help deserving and poor people particularly in rural areas within the territory of India in connection with their personal, social and cultural needs including health, education, marriages and others.
- (v) To found, assist and support, establish and maintain, libraries and Reading rooms and to establish and maintain Boarding Houses or to assist such institutions.

- (vi) To provide for endowment, stipends, scholarships and other allowances to deserving and needy students for promotion and encouragement of Educations.
- (vii) To open and maintain orphanages, widows homes and homes for blind and handicapped persons and to provide them vocational and other trainings or to render assistance to any such existing institution or institutions.
- (viii) To maintain, contribute or to give aid to any existing medical, Technical, professional, academic or Social Institutions or any charitable Institution with philanthropic purpose which may be in the general interest of the poor people.
- (ix) To maintain, aid and assist the institution or institutions carrying out activities for National Integration and reservation of secular character of the Nation.

- (xiii) To accept donations (in cash or kind) subscriptions, grants, presents and to collect dividends, rents, interests, and other income of the Trust fund etc., for being utilized to further the objects thereof.
- (xiv) To take over with all it's assets and liabilities or without previous liabilities and to own, maintain, manage and administer any existing educational institution including professional and technical colleges such as institute of science and technology, polytechnic, Medical College and Hospital, Dental College and Hospital,

MANAGEMENT OF TRUST

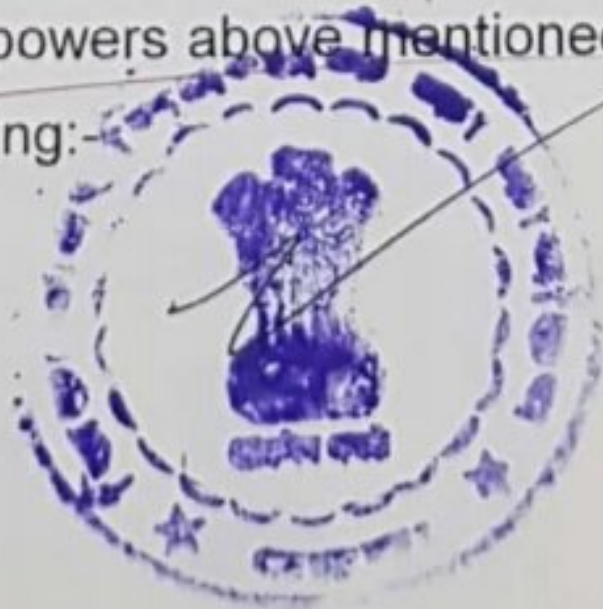
The General Management of the Trust for the purpose of managing the affairs and properties and carrying out the objects of the Trust aforesaid shall be vested in the Board of Trustees consisting of not less than three trustees and not more than seven trustees.

The Board of Trustees shall have one Chairman who shall be the principal executive officer of the Trust and one Secretary, who shall be the executive officer of the Trust. The First Chairman of the Trust shall be Mr. Abhishek Kumar Singh (Settlor) who holds office of the Chairman of this Trust for life and the First Secretary of the Trust shall be Smt. Neeta Kumari, who holds office of the Secretary of this Trust for life. During their life time they may nominate one of the trustee as his successor in office mutually. The Trustee so nominated shall enter into the office of the Chairman and the Secretary after the life time of the present Chairman and Secretary and If they fail to nominate their successor during their life time in that event after their life time the remaining Trustees shall elect one amongst themselves as the Chairman of the Board of Trustees and one amongst themselves as the Secretary and without prejudice to the generality of the objects and powers above mentioned, they shall have to do all or any of the following:-

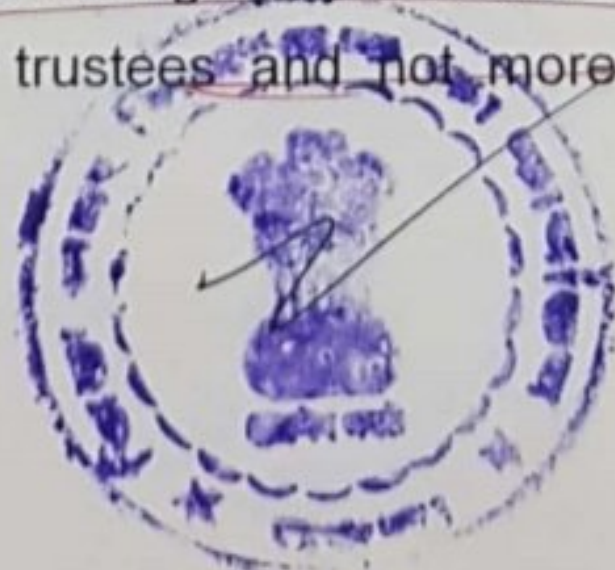

- (i) To enter into contracts and borrow money from Banks, institutions or individuals for the purpose of the Trust and management of its properties and assets.
- (ii) To engage consultants for specific purposes on such terms and conditions as they may deem fit.
- (iii) To enter into agreements with organizations and individuals for execution of any projects that may be undertaken to taken the Trust from time to time.
- (iv) To make rules and regulation from time to time for the management and conduct of the affairs of the Trust and it's properties and assets.
- (v) To appoint/select a trustee as a Treasurer, who will prepare Annual Budget, monthly and yearly expenditure statements get the expenditure audited by auditor duly appointed by the Board of Trustees and place them before the Board of Trustees for approval. The Treasurer is responsible to maintain cash book and prepare vouchers for the payments made, receive contributions, sign acknowledgements for the amounts or articles received by the Trust and prepare monthly and yearly statements of revenue and expenditure, as well as, the register of assets of the Trust and place them before the Board of Trustees for their approval.
- (vi) The Secretary shall be also responsible for the day to day administration activities of the Trust. The Secretary shall deal with correspondence received by the Trust, send replies in consultation with the Managing Trustee, Vice President and/or the Treasurer where necessary. He/she is responsible for the safe custody of all the properties and records of the Trust. The Secretary shall represent the Trust in all legal matters, sign the papers related to legal cases, attend to courts or represent the Trust in Government offices.

NUMBER OF TRUSTEES, THEIR TERM AND POWER TO CO-OPT:

The Trust will be managed by a Board of Trustees consisting of not less than three trustees and not more than seven trustees. The

The Board of Trustees shall have the power to increase the total number of Trustees upto the maximum number stated above and fix their term as per provisions contained herein.

Any Trustee may retire from the Trusteeship hereof by giving two calendar months notice in writing of his or her intention to do so, to the Board of Trustees and after the expiry of the period of notice, the Trustee giving the notice shall ipso facto cease to be a Trustee of these presents. Any vacancy caused by death of any one of the First Trustees, or any vacancy caused by the resignation of any of the Trustees, may be filled up by co-option by the Board of Trustees.

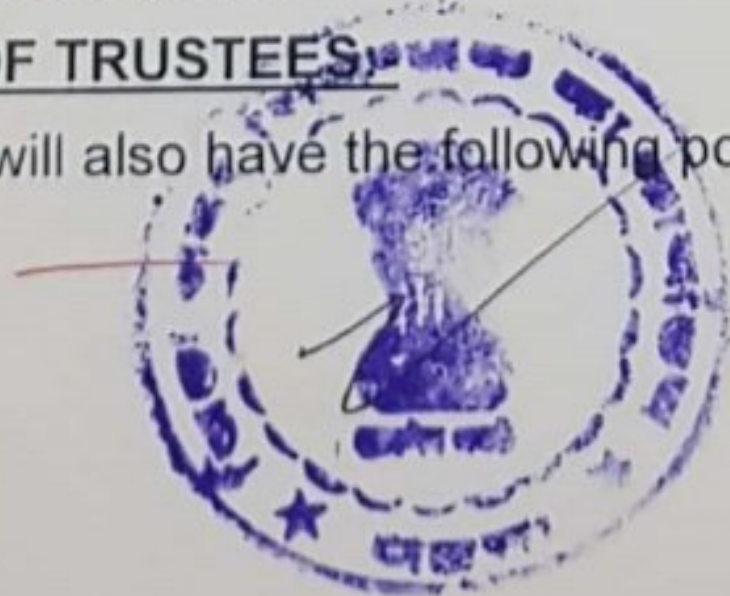
The Trustees who are not the Chairman, The Secretary, The treasurer and First Trustees shall hold office for a period of one year from their date of appointment by the Trustees. At the end of this one year period, the Board of Trustees may reappoint them for subsequent term or appoint other persons as Trustees in such a manner that the total number of Trustees does not exceed the approved maximum number of Trustees.

The Chairman and The Secretary mutually shall have the power to remove a Trustee suffering from physical or mental disability or if he/her is accused of misfeasance of trust funds or property or misconduct, after satisfying himself on enquiry and such action of the Chairman and The Secretary Trustee shall be final.

The proceedings of the Board of Trustees shall not in any way be invalidated due to any post or posts remaining vacant. During the time when a vacancy is yet to be filled up, the remaining Trustees shall act as "Full Board", subject to the presence of Quorum in the meetings. Any vacancy in the Board of Trustees or illegality in the appointment of Trustees or their proceedings shall not invalidate any prior act or decision of the Board.

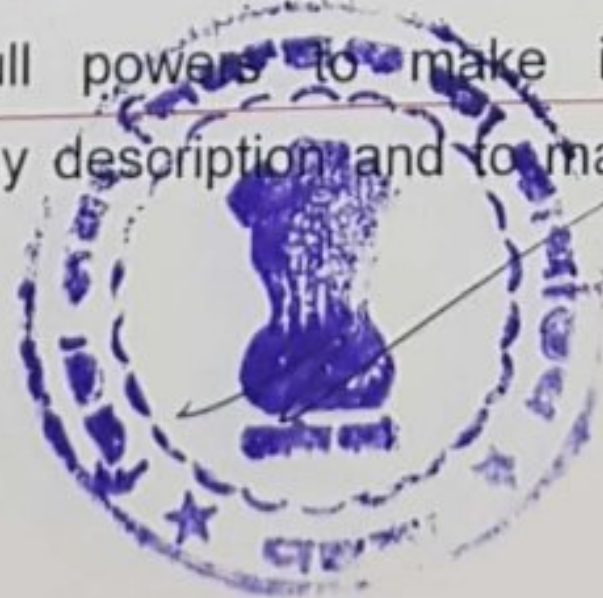

(v) The Trustees shall have powers to sell or assign any movable and immovable property or properties for the time being forming part of the Trust Fund either together or in parcels and either by public auction or private contract and either with or without any special or other stipulations as to title evidence of commencement of title or otherwise and to by in or rescind or vary any contract for sell or to re-sell without being made answerable for the loss occasioned thereby and for the purpose aforesaid or any of them to execute and do all such assurances, acts, deeds and things as they shall think fit and out of the moneys which shall arise from any such sale for the interest and of the Trust or otherwise in or about the execution of any of the Trusts or powers of these presents and shall stand possessed of the residue of the said moneys and also of the rents and profits of the said premises or of the unsold part thereof for the time being upon such Trust and subject to such powers, provisions, agreements and declaration as are herein declared PROVIDED, always that the Trustees shall manage any immovable property or properties for time being forming part of the Trust Fund in such manner as they shall think fit with full powers to make improvements, repairs or alternations of any description and to make or incur any outlay for

(xvi) To purchase or hire or to take on lease lands, buildings and other immovable and movable properties in the name of the Trust.

(xvii) To raise or borrow money required for the purpose of the Trust on mortgage or pledge of the Trust Estate or any part thereof with or without any security and at such rate of interest and on such terms as the Trustees shall think fit.

(xviii) To do such acts and things which may be incidental and necessary to attain the objectives of the Trust.

5. DUTIES OF THE TRUSTEES:-

(i) The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds that shall actually come into their hands, and shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts of commission or omission of the other Trustees nor of any Bankers or other persons with whom the Trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or handed over unless caused by their willful neglect or default.

(ii) All the Trustees shall be bound to maintain and defend all such suits and (subject to provision of this deed) to take such other steps as may be reasonably requisite for the conservation of the trust property and the assertion or protection of the title.

6. RIGHTS OF THE TRUSTEES:-

(i) The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration as Trustees but may reimburse themselves of all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with Trust or their duties relating thereto.

The Chairman of the Trust shall be the ex-office Chairman and the principal executive head of such committee(s) managing committee(s) or the Board of Directors constituted by the Board of Trustees. The Committee managing Committee or Board of Directors shall work under the direct control and supervision of the Board of Trustees.

(iii) The Trustees may from time to time frame schemes, rules, regulations, laws and Bye-law for regulating the affairs of the project undertaken by the Trust in pursuance to the various objects, such rules as framed by the Board of Trustees for the conduct of affairs of the project shall be binding and no deviation shall be permissible in any of the rules so framed by any authority whatsoever connected with the said project without the prior approval-1 of the Board of Trustees.

(iv) (a) The Trust may have an Advisory Committee of National Level to advise the Trustees on the activities of the Trust and to suggest how to make them better serve it's aim and objects. The strength of the Advisory committee shall not exceed 5 (five) at a given time. The members of the Advisory Committee shall serve the Trust in honorary capacity but they may be reimbursed such expenses as may be incurred by them for attending the meeting of the Advisory Committee, if so decided by the Trustees.

(b) The Advisory Committee appointed by the Board of Trustees shall function under the direct control of the trust and the chairman of the Board of Trustees shall act as ex-officio Chairman of the said Advisory Committee.

8. RULES OF THE TRUST:-

The Trustees of may from time to time frame rules for the conduct of the affairs of the Trust and regulating the meeting of the Trust in the absence of the regulation.

- (i) All matters will be decided by majority and three Trustees shall from a quorum for meeting of Trustees provided however if the number of Trustees fall below three of them for the purpose of appointing a Trustee two will be a quorum.
- (ii) Resolution passed by circulation with any meeting of the Trustees and thereof evidence in writing under the hands of three fourth of the Trustees or the number nearest thereto shall be as valid and effectual as resolution duly passed at the meeting of the Trustee.
- (iii) The Existing Trustees may appoint one or more Trustees at their discretion from time to time, but in any cases, the total number of the Trustees to be appointed shall not exceed seven

9. RESTRUCTUIB OR USE OF TRUST FUND AND DISPOSAL OF FUNDS ON DISSCUTION:-

- (iii) In the event of dissolution of the Trust which may be decided by unanimous resolution of Trustees, the funds held with the Trust on that date, will be donated to any other trust or Institution having similar objects as that of the Trust as determined by the Board of Trustees. However, no part of the funds of the Trust will, directly or indirectly be given to either of the Trustees or their relations.

In case of difference of opinion arising among the Trustees and in all matters where the Trustees shall have the discretionary power, the opinion arising among the Trustees and in all matters where the Trustees shall have the discretionary power, the opinion of the majority of the Trustees present except as provided in various foregoing clauses shall prevail and be binding on the majority as well as on those Trustees who may not have voted and if the Trustees are equally divided the matter shall be decided according to the casting vote of the chairman.

12. ALLOWANCE TO TRUSTEE AND OFFICE BEARERS:-

If at any time any Trustee acts as whole time office bearer of the Trust or renders and special service the Trustees may at their discretion pay such remuneration or allowance to him as they may think proper.

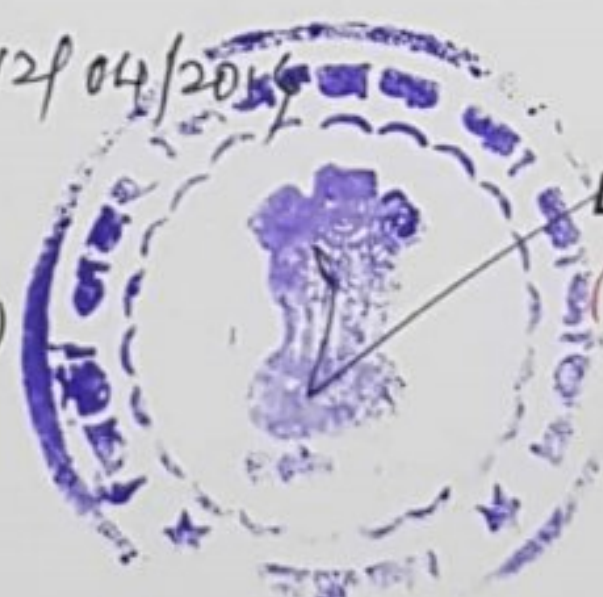
